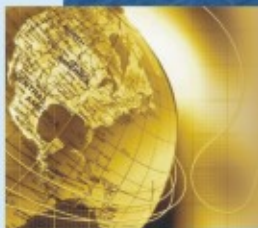

Information in connection with Admission to Diploma Courses :

The candidates should submit their application in the prescribed form with necessary documents to the admission committee of Ramkhauli Lingade Polytechnic College before the day prescribed by the institute.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission To First Year Diploma Courses :

For Maharashtra State

The candidates must have passed Secondary School Certificate [S.S.C.] Examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education or equivalent examination with and in (1) General Science or Physics & Chemistry, (2) Elementary Mathematics or Algebra & Geometry, and (3) English with at least 50% marks in aggregate for open category and in case of backward class at least 45% belonging to Maharashtra State.

Admission Rules & Regulations will be as per the directives of The Director, Technical Education, Mumbai.

Note:- The term "aggregate marks" used here shall mean the grand total marks obtained by the candidate taken together for all the subjects, whether compulsory or optional.

DOMICILE CERTIFICATE

- If the candidate has passed VIII, IX and X std. from recognized school in Maharashtra State, domicile certificate is not essential.
- Sons/daughters of employees of
 - Government of India or [II] Undertaking of Government of India shall be eligible for admission, even though such an employee is domiciled in any other state or union territory, and even though the candidate does not satisfy the conditions mentioned in (a) above, provided that [I] such employee has been transferred to Maharashtra within a period of two years prior to the last date of submission of application forms, and, [II] has joined the post in Maharashtra before the last date of submission of application forms, and, [III] has not been transferred out of Maharashtra thereafter.
- Sons/daughters of persons domiciled in Maharashtra will also be eligible for admission even if they do not satisfy the conditions mentioned in (a) above, provided that the candidate produces a domicile certificate in respect of his / her father/mother. In case of mother's domicile certificates, the candidate shall submit an affidavit on Rs. 10 stamp paper, stating that the person in whose name the

domicile certificate is issued is the mother of the candidate.

The domicile certificate issued by the Government Authorities only from the state of Maharashtra such as Executive Magistrate, Sub divisional Magistrate and as authorized by the District Magistrate shall be acceptable.

Note : The domicile certificate by choice or domicile certificate for educational purpose shall not be considered.

FOR OTHER STATE

The candidates from outside the Maharashtra State must have passed SSC exam from board recognized by M.S. Board of Secondary Education, Pune, Maharashtra with subjects.

- General Science or Physics
- Mathematics or Algebra & Geometry and
- English

with individual passing in each subject by securing minimum 50% marks in aggregate. Admission Rules & Regulations will be per the directives to The Director, Technical Education, M.S..

Note:- The term "aggregate marks" used here shall mean the grand total marks obtained by the candidate, taken together for all the subjects, whether compulsory or optional.

RELATIVE MERIT IN CASE OF EQUAL MARKS

In case of the i.e. candidates having equal marks, in qualifying examination i.e. X std. the inter-se-merit of candidates shall be reassessed as laid down below :

- A candidate passing H.S.S.C. [Std. XII] Science stream examination at (10+2) level will have first priority.
- A candidate passing XII std. with M.C.V.C. will have second priority.
- A candidate who secured higher marks in the subject of Maths at S.S.C. examination will have fourth priority.
- A candidate who secured higher marks in the subject of science at the S.S.C. examination will have fifth priority.

Special Provision For other State Candidates

After exhaustion of the general merit list of the candidates from Maharashtra, vacant seats, if any in the unaided institutions, can be offered to the candidates from the other states and Union territories on merit basis. These admissions shall be

done by the Head of the Institution, to the extent of 20% of sanctioned intake.

DIRECT ADMISSION TO SECOND AND THIRD YEAR

- The candidate passing the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination with Vocational or Technical subjects or equivalent declared by the M.S. Board are eligible.
- There is 10% reservation for such candidates over and above the sanctioned intake.
- It is compulsory for the student to produce eligibility certificate from MSBTE, R.O., Nagpur, for admission.
- These admissions are subject to the approval of the Joint Director, Directorate of Technical Education, Regional Office, Nagpur.

Students after passing diploma examination in one branch can directly get admitted to other allied branch at third year level [i.e. Double Diploma].

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- A School or college leaving certificate.
- Certificate or examination passed [S.S.C. Examination and other examinations for which additional credit is given, if any] with the statement of marks.
- Certificate of date of birth, if it is not mentioned in the school or college leaving certificate.
- Certificate of "Physical Fitness" in the attached format by registered medical practitioner.
- Certificate from the proper authority regarding caste, if the candidate claims to belong to the "Backward class" of this state.
- Requisite certificate from the competent authority.

authorities in the case of candidates claiming to be the children or killed / disabled personnel in the Indo-Pak conflict.

- Certificate in case of candidates claiming to be freedom-fighter, his wife, child [including adopted and step child] and grandchild [child of the predeceased son.]
- Certificate of physical disability in the attached form, if applicable.
- Certificate of participation in sports, games, debate competitions etc. at national & state level.

Note : Candidates belonging to backward Classes are required to produce certificate of their caste from an Executive Magistrate authorised by the District Magistrate.

Note for other than Maharashtra candidates (O.M.S.): In case of candidate from other state, the statement of marks for SSC or equivalent should be in English only, clearly mentioning the name of subjects and in case where the marksheet is in language other than English, it should be translated to English by the competent authority.

Competent authorities for translation and attestation:-

- Secretary, Board of respective Secondary or Higher Secondary Education.
- Head Master/Principal of the last school attended by the candidate.
- Executive Magistrate.
- Government approved translator.

Medium of Instruction :

The medium of Instruction and Examination is English.

Structure of the Course, Syllabus & Examining Authority :-

The Structure of the Course & Syllabus is as prescribed by Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education, Mumbai (MSBTE) and MSBTE conducts the examination based on the prescribed syllabus in summer and winter every year. The detailed information regarding syllabus, examination is available on website www.msbtel.com

Attendance and Sessional Examination :-

Student must be regular and punctual in attending classes, laboratories, practical, tutorials, assignments and seminars etc. and in submission of team-work in the various subjects. Terms may not be granted and the students may not be certified for the examination due to his/her lack of progress including the performance in the mid-session test or sessional exam etc., conduct, attendance etc. is not satisfactory.

Dress Code :-

Uniform is compulsory. Uniform is decided by the Institution. Students without uniform will not be allowed to attend the Institute.

Conduct and Discipline :-

Students while studying in the Institute if found indulging in anti-national activities contrary to the provisions of Acts and Laws enforced by Government will be eligible to be expelled from the institute without any notice by the Principal.

The student is expected to maintain a high standard of discipline and observe all such rules and regulations of the college as are displayed on the college notice board from time to time. Breach of the institute rule is construed as indiscipline behavior for which student may be penalised.

Following Acts will be treated as Indiscipline

- Disregard of Institute orders and notices.
- Disregard of orders and instructions of the staff members.
- Persistent neglect of studies.
- Recourse to unfair means at any examinations.
- Participation in strikes and and morchas etc
- Students during training in industry must conform industrial discipline and follow factory rules in regard to attendance, holiday, times, dress etc.
- No Society, association or club shall be formed by

the students without prior permission of the Principal.

- Ragging is cognizable offence and this will invariably lead to expulsion from the Institute.

General Instructions For Students

- Student must abide by the rules and regulations framed by the Institute from time to time.
- The Principal reserves the right to strike off the name of the student from the roll, if the student remains absent without informing the Institute.
- For misbehavior of any nature the student would be liable to severe punishment by the Principal at his discretion and he may even be debarred from the Institution
- No student will be allowed to appear for the semester examination of the Board unless: a) He has requisite percentage of attendance, followed by a clearance certificate from all concerned teacher, b) He has performed all the practicals & submitted record of his performance to his subject teacher's satisfaction, c) He has paid all dues.
- The student must wear a boiler suit in the workshop.
- Taking loudly, loitering, smoking / chewing tobacco or gutka at unauthorised assembly is banned. Students found indulging in such activities will be punished and serious action will be taken against them.
- In all case of absence an application duly endorsed by the guardians stating valid reasons for the absence must be sent to the office immediately and in case of absence on medical ground the application must be supported by Medical Certificate from registered medical practitioner along with bills of medicines.
- A student is expected to read the notices displayed on the notice board of the Institute. The Institute is not responsible for any loss or damage caused to the student due to his failure to read the notice in time.
- Bicycles, Scooters etc. should be parked only in the area provided for the purpose. The Institute will not be responsible for any loss or damages.
- Any change in the address of the student must be notified to the office of the Institution immediately.
- Student staying outside Nagpur can avail the facility of M.S.R.T bus and railway concession as per rules.
- Each student must be aware of teaching and examination scheme, syllabus of his subjects, and rules & regulations

IMPORTANT REGULATIONS PASSED BY MSBTE

RG-4 : No candidate will be admitted to any semester/year Examination unless he keeps term for that semester/year at an institute recognised by the Director of Technical Education, M.S. and affiliated to the Board of Technical Education

- a) Compulsory attendance 75% in theory / practical / termwork each.
- b) Satisfactory completed the specified Lab. practicals, Term-work, sessional etc.
- c) Satisfactory progress in his studies and is of good conduct and character.
- d) Not been debarred for any period from appearing for any examinations.

RG-7 : A Candidate who has failed to pass in any of the term work / examination whenever prescribed for any semester / year examination will be admitted to the succeeding semester / year if otherwise eligible. However, such candidates shall submit fresh term work by rejoining the institute in related subject/s in which he has failed and passes in the subsequent examination. In case Institute cannot arrange timetable for such candidates for two semester / year during the same time period then such candidates should not be allowed to join higher semester / year though result status is ATKT till the candidate completes fresh term work and passes successfully in

the term work in which he has failed at lower semester/ year. Completion of fresh term work shall be certified as per RG-4
